I am happy to provide a reference for the work that Martin Dillon delivered to Network Rail at Allerton Railway Depot Project.

Martin Dillon was initially engaged on our multi £m Northern Rail Allerton Depot Upgrade Project in September 2011 to execute the following activities:

- Excavation for new trainwash foundation slab and drainage assets
- Shuttering and placement of Rebar
- Drainage and service trench installation
- Casting of C40 concrete
- RC Construction of modular building slabs
- Temporary works for deep drainage
- Klargest tank installation
- Troughing

Despite a short notice period for mobilisation, Martin and his team of Groundworkers, Carpenters, Steelfixers and Plant Operators executed the above works to budget, programme, no accidents or near misses and with minimal snags.
